White Construction Group Announces Contract For Structural Repairs to Pahaska Teepee and Chief Hosa Lodge

CASTLE ROCK, Colo., Dec. 21, 2004 – White Construction Group, a Colorado-based construction firm specializing in commercial construction, design-build, historic renovations and tenant improvement projects, today announced that it has been commissioned as the general contractor for structural repairs to two historic Denver Mountain Park properties in Evergreen, Colo. - Pahaska Teepee and Chief Hosa Lodge. The repairs involve structural reinforcement utilizing segments of structural steel pipe bolted to the existing log roof system. The structural steel pipe segments will be of similar diameter and fit tightly to the reinforced logs, minimizing visual impact. Both buildings will remain in use during the entire project. The project is valued at \$512,226, and is expected to begin February 2005.
