White Construction Group Begins Library Project at University of Colorado at Boulder

CASTLE ROCK, Colo., July 14, 2008 –White Construction Group, a Colorado-based commercial general construction firm, recently began the renovation/remodel of the University of Colorado at Boulder Norlin Library.

The project consists of a 43,000 sq-ft. renovation and remodel of four floors on the eastern side of the library with a 330 sq-ft. addition to the southeast corner on the first floor. Work on the fourth floor includes the addition to two handicap lifts and miscellaneous remodel work. The project is expected to be completed May 2009.
