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WHITE CONSTRUCTION GROUP BEGINS CARLSBAD CAVERNS PROJECT

CASTLE ROCK, Colo., Sept 15, 2010 –White Construction Group, a Colorado-based commercial general construction firm, began renovation work for the National Park Service (NPS) on the main elevator system at the Carlsbad Caverns National Park.

This project involves the replacement of structural steel beams and guiderail supports in the 754-foot deep primary elevator shaft at Carlsbad Cavern. Installed in 1955, the steel beams had corroded during 55 years of exposure to the moist cave environment. This complex project will address NPS concerns for safety and resource protection, such as minimizing noise in order to not disturb the park's famous bat populations. While this eight month-long project is underway, the smaller secondary elevators will continue to carry park visitors into and out of the cavern.
