## **White Construction Group To Complete Victorian Gazebo on Castle Rock's Main Street**

**Construction firm donates labor, helps organize construction  
of Victorian-style gazebo for community performances**

*CASTLE ROCK, Colo., May 6, 2004* – White Construction Group (*formerly Ash & White Construction Co.*), a Colorado-based construction firm specializing in commercial construction, design-build and historic restoration projects, is helping to lead a collective effort to build a Victorian-style gazebo on Castle Rock's main street. This gazebo will replace a historic gazebo that was removed in the 1970s.

The gazebo project started when Kent Brandebery, the founder of the Castle Rock Band, wanted to know what happened to the old Castle Rock bandstand. Ultimately, Brandebery located the old bandstand in an alley in a state of disrepair.

His finding kick-started community discussions on building another gazebo that would serve as a bandstand for public concerts and events. Ultimately, the grounds of the new Philip S. Miller library on Wilcox St were slated for the location of the new gazebo. Then, community and business leaders worked together to make the gazebo a reality.

White Construction Group handled the pre-construction planning and built a list of materials that would be needed. White Construction Group helped secured materials donations of lumber and concrete to build the project and also is donating a significant portion of the labor. Humphries Poli Architects PC donated the design work.

In the spirit of a small town, community leaders are planning a series of “barn-raisings” in which local construction workers and “handy” community members will help build and paint the gazebo.

“When we were approached to help make the gazebo a reality, we agreed immediately and are behind this project 100 percent,” said Tim White, president of White Construction Group. “One of the real charms of Castle Rock is its small town atmosphere and how people band together on activities that make Castle Rock a better place to live. We are glad to be able to help construct a project that will bring people together and offer a venue for live music and special events.”

### **Construction Details: A Victorian-style gazebo built with modern materials**

- **Square feet:** 350
- **Location:** Northwest edge of the Philip S. Miller Library, Castle Rock
- **Project value:** \$90,000\*  
*\*\$20,000 of this budget was offset when the Philip S. Miller library offered to handle the landscaping.*
- **Construction detailing:** This Victorian-style gazebo will stand four feet off the ground and will feature a cupola and weathervane. Lattice work will wrap around the outer perimeter of the structure. The floor of the gazebo will feature plastic decking, which will minimize maintenance requirements and will withstand Colorado’s extreme temperature fluctuations and high ultraviolet light.
